Conditions of Entry

To be read in conjunction with the Waipu Caledonian Society Solo Drumming Rules. These are available on the Waipu Highland Games website.

1. All **registered** entries received before the cut-off date will receive a free gate and car pass. No gate and car passes will be distributed to entrants following this date.
2. The competition shall be conducted under the Solo Drumming Rules of the Waipu Caledonian Society.
3. Due to scheduling and planning constraints, entries to all events may be declined on the day. This decision will be based solely on the discretion of the contest organisers.
4. All snare drum competitors are to be accompanied by a piper and all tenor and bass competitors are to be accompanied by a piper and snare drummer.
5. Competitors must report to Board Stewards upon arrival at the grounds. A guide to event times will be made available to competitors prior to the contest.
6. 2 entries are required before an event will be held.
7. Prizes are awarded on the basis of entries per event. **Accordingly, for an event with 2-3 entries 1st prize will be awarded, for an event with 4-5 entries 1st and 2nd prizes will be awarded, for an event with 6-7 entries 1st, 2nd, and 3rd prizes will be awarded and for an event with 8 or more entries 1st, 2nd, 3rd and 4th will be awarded if there is a 4th prize for that event.**
8. No animals are allowed into the Caledonian Park. This is a Health and Safety requirement and will duly be enforced.

Entries close on the 30th of November 2018 and a late penalty of a double entry fees may be incurred after this date
